Friday Night Movie focuses on the "lost boys" of Sudan

The Sojourner's Class at St. John's Lutheran-Salisbury will present the movie 'Lost Boys of Sudan' on **Friday, March 16 at 7:00p.m.**

ATTENTION!

In the late '80's, Islamic fundamentalists in Sudan waged war on the country's separatists, leaving behind over 20,000 male orphans, otherwise known as the "lost boys." Of those that survived and found their way to refugee camps, some were chosen to participate in a resettlement program in America. The movie 'Lost Boys of Sudan' focuses on two boys during their first year in the United States. Safe at last, the boys must still grapple with cultural differences and both the abundance and alienation of contemporary American life.

Ms. Cindy Castano, a member of the Board of Directors of the non-profit organization, Darfur Peace and Development, will lead the discussion after the movie. She is very familiar with the aid work being done in the area and is currently working on the production of documentaries focusing on Darfur and the Sudan.
