### **Freeing Slaves in South East Asia**

**Special Guest: Aaron Cohen, Anti-Slavery Consultant and Undercover Agent**

Former executive director of rock band Jane’s Addiction, Aaron Cohen has over a decade of experience in the field of human rights intelligence, military paramilitary slave retrievals and human rights advocacy. His work and assessments have influenced the U.S. State Department annual report in Trafficking in Human Persons, the Trafficking Victim Protection Act of 2000 and the Sudan Peace Act of 2003. Perhaps more compelling are his first-hand experiences working to extricate victims of human slavery from their desperate circumstances. Next year, Cohen will be awarded the 2008 Prize for Humanity from the Immortal Chaplains Foundation for his work in this field. He has traveled extensively and worked with many people in many capacities with the single-minded focus of eradicating slavery.
