Slavery in Sudan

Join Cindy in an in-depth interview with Dr. John Eibner who has just returned from Sudan where he witnessed the slow crumbling of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement between North and South Sudan that could catapult the country into war and genocide beyond Darfur and beyond comprehension. There is hope however and Dr. Eibner's many years experience in the humanitarian and political arena of Sudan will help us understand some of the hard issues and tell us why we should care, how the genocide affects us in the United States. Dr. Eibner is one of the pre-eminent anti-slavery campaigners of modern times. He has served as CSI's main representative at the United Nations, Geneva and has appeared before the US House of Representatives, Sub-Committee on Africa, the Congressional Human Rights Caucus, and the UN Commission on Human Rights. In this role as advocate, Eibner has testified on behalf of the Sudanese slaves and other victims of the National Islamic Front's jihad (Islamic Holy War) against the country's black African Christians and other minority groups. He has frequently briefed senior policy makers at the White House and State Department.
